

<p style="text-align: center;">Creed</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">A summary of what people believe. The Apostles' Creed is a summary of Christian beliefs.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Gospel</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">The Good News of God's love for us. In the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, we learn the story of Jesus' Life, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Homily</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">An explanation of God's Word. A homily explains how to live according to the message we hear in the readings at Mass.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">New Testament</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">The second part of the Bible. In the New Testament, we read the story of Jesus and the early Church.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Old Testament</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">The first part of the Bible. In the Old Testament, we read the story of how God prepared the people for the coming of Jesus.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Psalm</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">A prayer in the form of a poem. There are 150 Psalms in the Old Testament Book of Psalms.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Sacred Scripture</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">The holy writings of Jews and Christians, collected in the Old and New Testaments to form the Bible. At Mass, we hear God's Word proclaimed from Sacred Scripture in the Mass readings.</p>
